Isaiah 52:7-8

How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of those who bring good news, who proclaim peace, who bring good tidings, who proclaim salvation, who say to Zion, “Your God reigns! ⁸ Listen! Your watchmen lift up their voices; together they shout for joy. When the Lord returns to Zion, they will see it with their own eyes.

Pray the Word:

Right now, I shout for joy knowing victory is chasing _____. I declare we will see them return to You with our own eyes! I praise you, Lord, for your faithfulness in preparing the way and removing all obstacles for them to come home.

Zechariah 10:6b-12

I will restore them because I have compassion on them.

**They will be as though I had not rejected them,
for I am the Lord their God and I will answer them.**

You are faithful and bringing _____ back to your pasture and there will not be room enough for them. _____ may pass through the sea of trouble, but the surging sea will be subdued, and all the depths of the Nile will dry up. Nothing can stop your child from coming home! Forever more, _____ will depend on you and seek your face, not your hand. _____ will live securely forever in your love, in your will, and in your Promised land! You are Faithful! IT IS DONE!
